Faithshire Corporation ("FC") respects your privacy and is committed to protecting the confidentiality of your personal information. FC established this Privacy Policy in order to establish rules which govern the collection, use and disclosure of personal information in a manner which recognizes your right to privacy while recognizing FC's need to collect personal information for appropriate business use.

The Collection of Personal Information

Personal information¹ includes any factual or subjective information, recorded about an identifiable individual. FC collects personal information only for the following purposes:

- To establish and maintain responsible commercial relations with its clients and suppliers in order to provide you with ongoing services;
- To establish and maintain communications with its clients;
- To understand its clients' needs to recommend suitable products and services;
- To develop, enhance and market its products and services;
- To manage personnel and employment matters; and
- To meet legislative requirements.

FC will not use your personal information for any other purpose without your consent. When dealing with FC, we will obtain personal information about you, which is kept on file in accordance with current legislation. Only authorized individuals and entities have access to this information.

Social Insurance Number

If you are an individual investor, FC must collect, use and disclose you SIN for income tax reporting purposes.

Disclosure of Personal Information to External Sources

FC may, from time to time, verify certain personal information provided by you with other institutions, namely, but not limited to, banks. Such verification is typically limited to determining if an account is open and in good standing.

¹ Personal information does not include name, title, business address, email address or telephone number of a business, professional person or employee of an organization.

Affiliated Companies

FC may from time to time disclose your personal information to companies affiliated with FC for the purpose of fulfilling, servicing and completing your requests and the transactions related thereto. These affiliates may be in Canada or in other parts of the world.

Corrections to Personal Information

You can review your information held by FC at anytime and make corrections to it. We require that such corrections be submitted in writing. Retention of Personal Information

FC may retain your personal information on file even if you cease to be a lessor/lessee of FC for as long as FC is required to maintain such information by law.

Protection of Your Information

Where appropriate, FC uses encryption and/or authentication tools to protect certain web-based personal information. Emails you forward to FC are not necessarily secure; if your communication is sensitive or includes confidential information, you may choose to provide it by post or via telephone.

Consent

Your consent is required before FC can provide your information to any third party not named in this disclosure document. The consent that you provide to FC with regards to the collection, use and disclosure of your personal information may be cancelled at any time by providing written notice to FC. By law FC does not require your consent to collect, use and disclose your personal information where:

- Such collection, use and disclosure is reasonably required in the normal course of business, namely the providing of investment advice and services to you;
- For the collection of debts owed to FC by you;
- To a law enforcement agency or government authority; and
- To FC's legal counsel for the purposes of obtaining advice.

By being an account with FC, you are providing consent to FC to collect, use and disclose your personal information as set out in this disclosure.
